	<i>At 6 o'clock:</i> If you get up (now) you will be in time for school.		<i>At 7 o'clock:</i> If you got up now you could be in time for school.		<i>At 9 o'clock:</i> If you had gotten up you would have been in time for school.
<b>Positiver Satz</b> If you <u>stay</u>	I <b>will</b> tell you.	<b>Positiver Satz</b> If you <u>stayed</u>	I <b>would</b> tell you.	<b>Positiver Satz</b> If you <b>had stayed</b>	I <b>would have told</b> you.
<b>Negativer Satz</b> If it <u>rains</u>	we <u>won't go</u> out.	<b>Negativer Satz</b> If it rained	we <u>would not go</u> out.	<b>Negativer Satz</b> If it <b>had</b> rained	we <u>would not have</u> <b>gone</b> out.
<b>Fragesatz</b> If I <u>tell</u> you a secret,	will you keep it?	<b>Fragesatz</b> If I told you a secret,	would you keep it?	<b>Fragesatz</b> If I <b>had</b> told you a secret,	would you <b>have</b> <b>kept</b> it?
