If-clauses

Typ 1

„Was **ist**, wenn“

Bildung:

If clause

Main clause

Simple **Present**

Will + Infinitive

Beispiele



At 6 o'clock:
If you get up (now)
you will be in time
for school.

Positiver Satz

If you stay

I **will** tell you.

Negativer Satz

If it rains

we won't go out.

Fragesatz

If I tell you a secret,

will you keep it?

Typ 2

„Was **wäre**, wenn“

Bildung:

If clause

Main clause

Simple **Past**

Would/ could/ might
+ Infinitive

Beispiele



At 7 o'clock:
If you got up now
you could be in
time for school.

Positiver Satz

If you stayed

I would tell you.

Negativer Satz

If it rained

we would not go
out.

Fragesatz

If I told you a secret,

would you keep it?

Typ 3

„Was **wäre gewesen**, wenn....“

Bildung:

If clause

Main clause

Past Perfect

Would **have** / could
have / might **have** +
Past Participle

Beispiele



At 9 o'clock:
If you had gotten up
you would have
been in time for
school.

Positiver Satz

If you had stayed

I would have told
you.

Negativer Satz

If it **had** rained

we would not have
gone out.

Fragesatz

If I **had** told you a
secret,

would you **have**
kept it?
